- Vocational training
- After-school program teaching math, English, & computer skills
- Hot meals for children
- Children's Club and playground

With 42% of the Arab world's population under age 20, we at AWM knew we must focus considerable efforts on this vital segment. ### *Reaching the Outsider*

There are many minority groups in the Arab world that we want to reach with the Gospel message. Reaching ethnic groups in the Arab world, such as the Bedouins, Gypsies, Druze, Kurds, and Alawites and more has required the use of many creative methods.

### *Reaching the Suffering*

Our goal is to create new believers and true disciples who become disciple-makers in time. We do this through dedicated time poured into the lives of new believers to develop and foster relationships, establish home groups, and institute a strategic, staged 3-year discipleship plan.
