Concept and Vision



- CETHEM (Theological Education Center of Miragoâne) exists to impact and empower church leaders to make disciples for the glory of God
- Currently, CETHEM uses an elementary school limited to weekend-only classroom education
- God revealed to us that CETHEM can expand its influence by increasing meeting frequency
 - *The **Vision** is to provide a local, dedicated facility for full-time theological education*
 - *Goal of initiative is to get sponsors to prayerfully consider financially supporting this capital campaign*
- Many leaders are bi-vocational; CETHEM will equip them with job skills training to allow them to provide for their families with dignity
- As Haiti is subject to frequent exposures to natural disasters, the facility will be used as a community shelter

CETHEM: Current State and History



Current State

- Due to the socio-political crisis in Haiti, many church leaders fled Haiti seeking safer environments
- Result is a leadership void in the evangelical churches that must be addressed

CETHEM History

- CETHEM is a Bible and Theological institution in Miragoâne founded in 2012 by *Jean Junior JOSEPH*, a graduate of Dallas Theological Seminary in Texas with a M.Th. degree (Masters of Theology)
- Having deep roots in Haiti, Jean and his wife Jean Marie traveled to Haiti and met with the Dean of the seminary of Port-au-Prince
- A connection was made with two graduates originally from Miragoâne who heard the vision and were committed to bringing CETHEM to fruition
- Since 2012, CETHEM has been serving the greater South and West regions of Haiti to provide theological based education to church leaders
- Since inception, CETHEM has educated over 400 pastors and church pastors impacting their local churches and communities for Christ

CETHEM Campaign: Objectives and Financial Targets

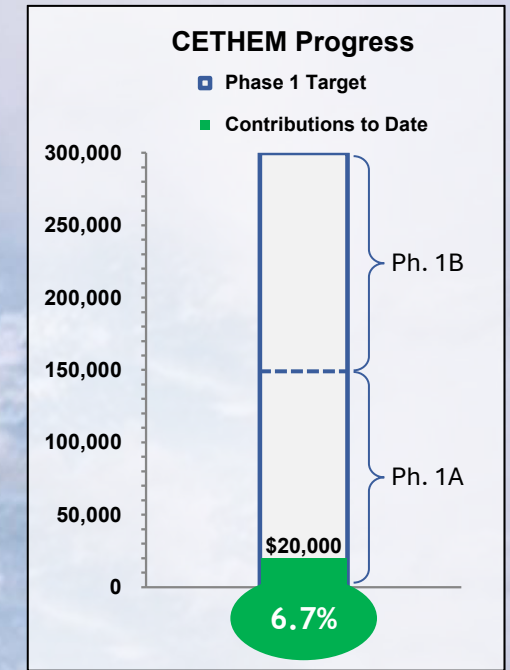


Objectives

- Solicit funds to establish a permanent facility that fosters learning and spiritual development
- CETHEM philosophy is donor driven so church leaders can receive a quality education at minimal tuition cost
- Implement a phased construction approach commiserate with school priorities
- Provide an elite theological education and vocational job skills training to church leaders

Financial Targets

- **Phase 1:** funding goal of \$300K with an aspired target completion of Dec. 2026
 - Includes classrooms, administration building and library
 - Threshold ~\$150K for “minimal” buildout (classes, parking, site prep)
- **Phase 2:** includes chapel and multi-purpose building at an estimated cost of \$250-\$300K
 - Notional timing is 2028-2029
- **Phase 3:** includes outside recreation and reflection areas with additional parking for ~\$150K
 - Timing TBD
- **Total estimated project cost is \$700 - \$800K**

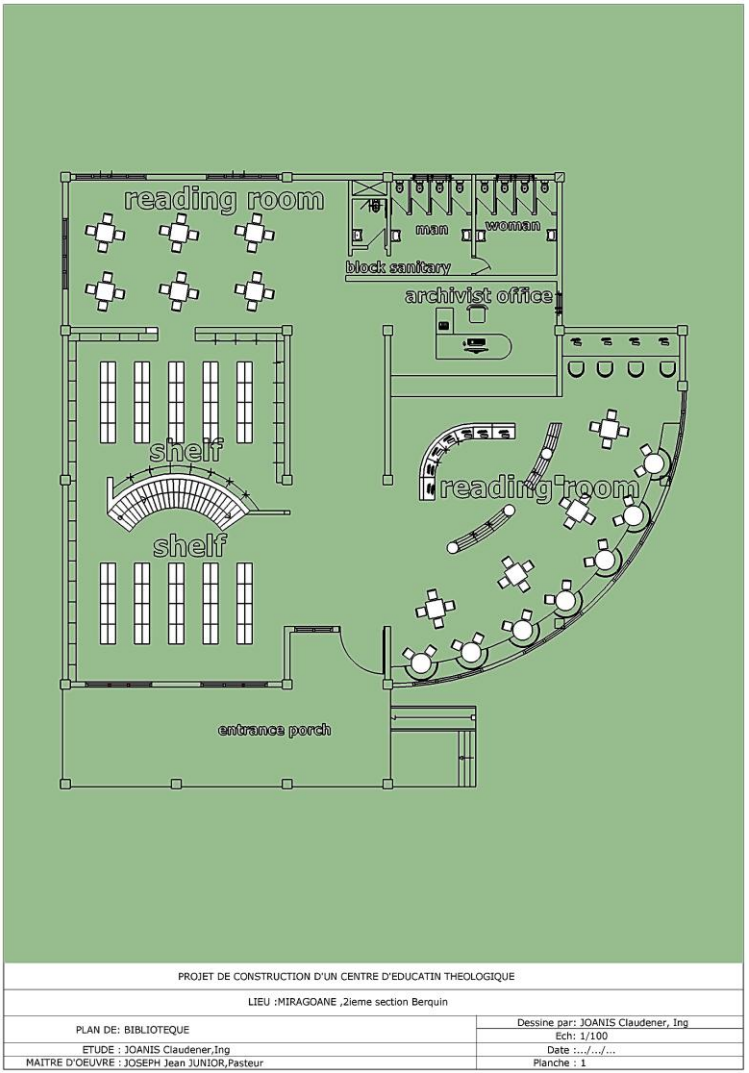


CETHEM Phased Development Concept

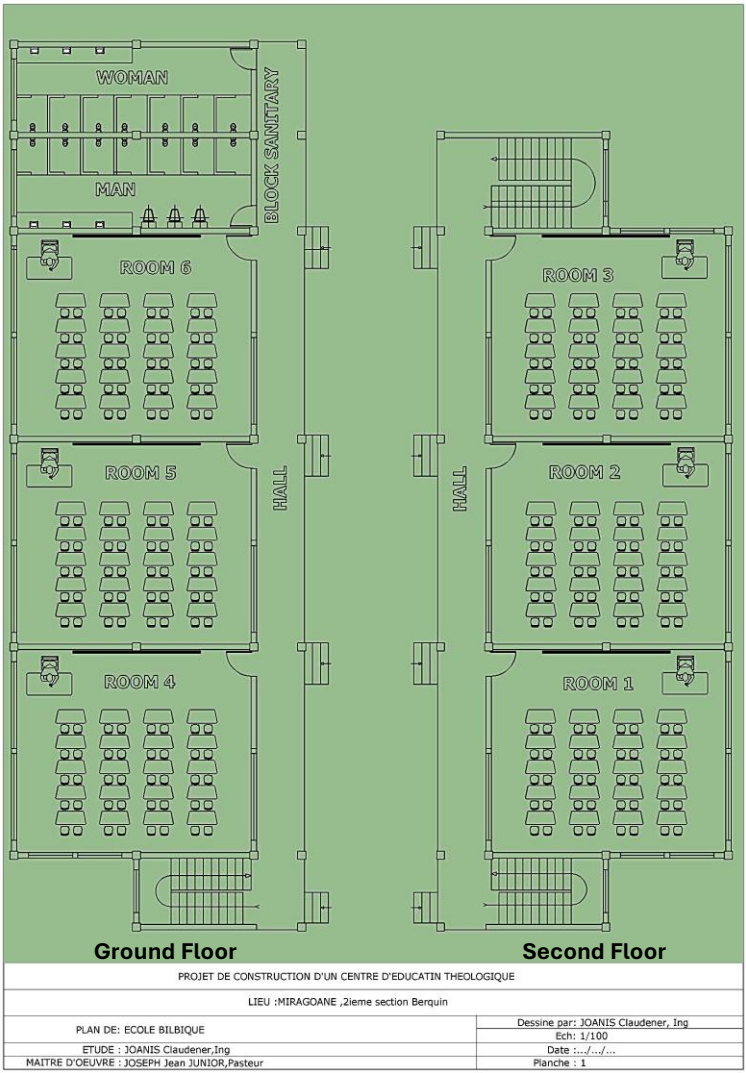


- In 2012, 1.8 acres (7,310 m²) plot of land gifted to CETHEM

Additional parking*

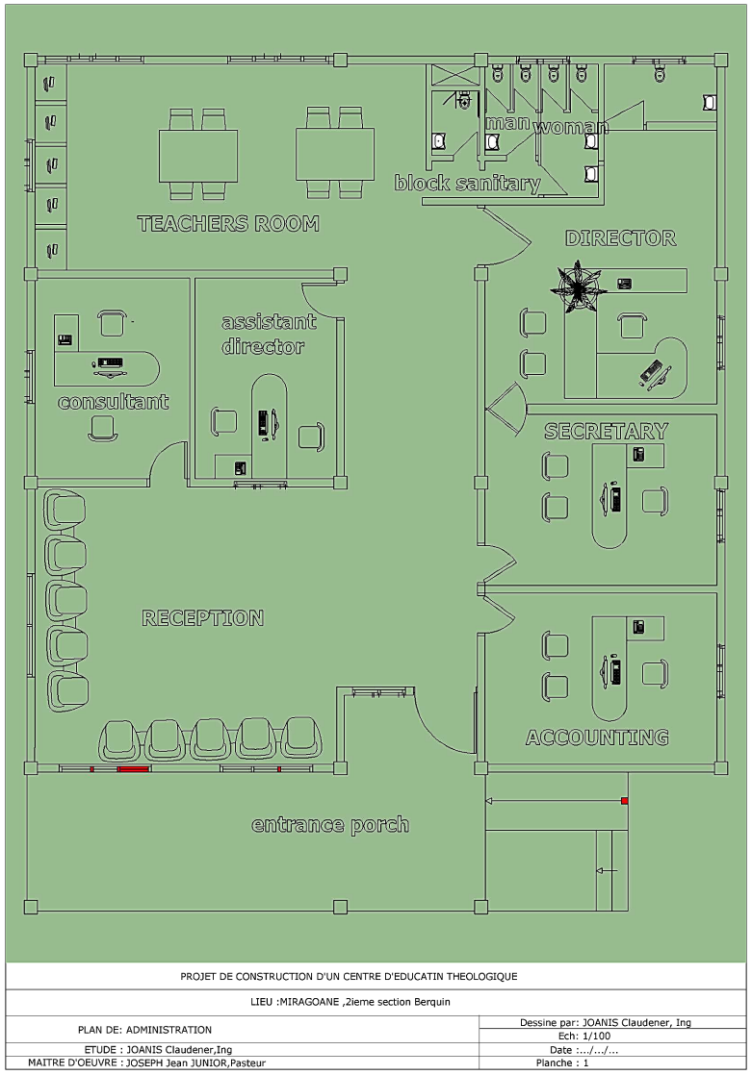
Phase 1: Detailed Renderings

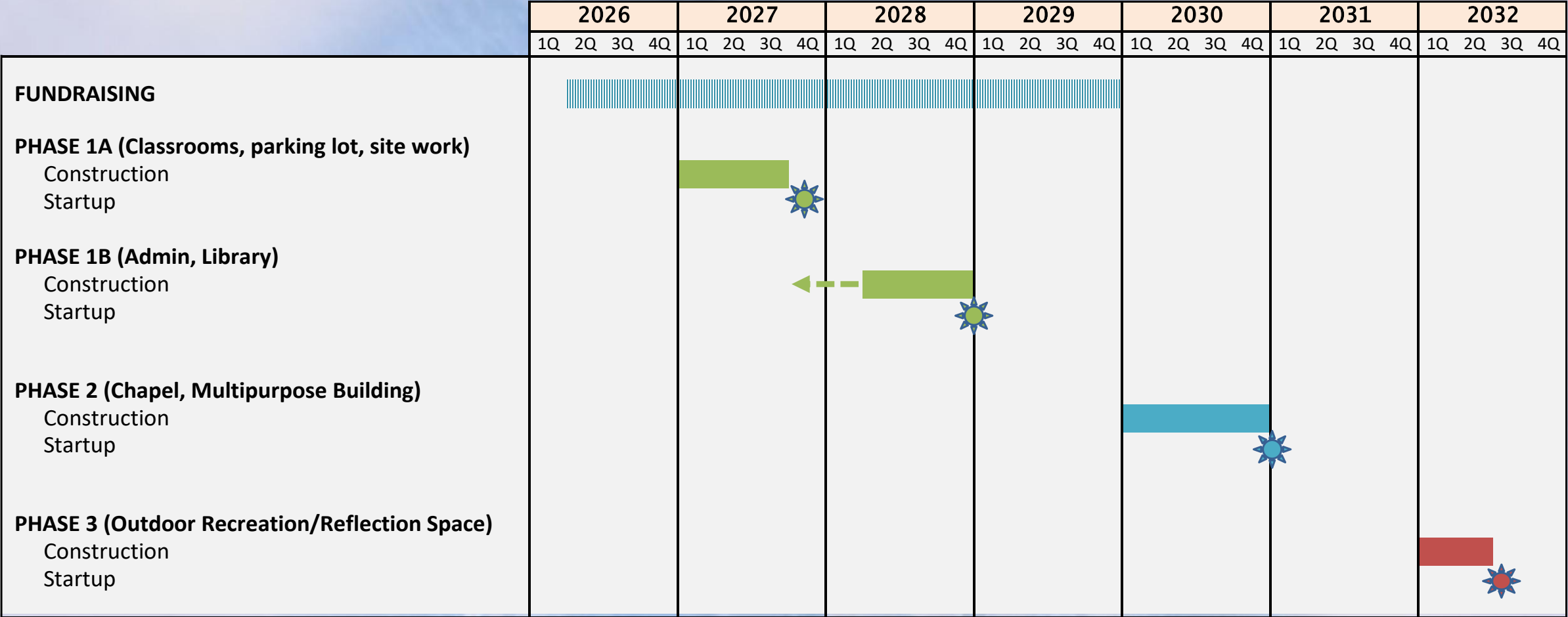


Classrooms
